

PINCHBECK – full circle

Pinchbeck is a village near Spalding in South Lincolnshire. Until mid-1904 Pinchbeck was served by a Receiving agent who accepted mail, cancelled it away from the stamp and then took it to Spalding where the stamp was cancelled and put into the postal system. From 1904 to 24th September 2014 it had a standalone Post office but since 25th September it has a community post office in a local shop.
