No postal concessions were granted to servicemen receiving underpaid mail in the UK.



May 19th 1917 unpaid picture postcard from Southampton to a soldier in The Worcester Regiment based in Swindon. ½d surcharge originally indicated and obliterated by the 727 number half of a Southampton duplex canceller. Correctly replaced by 1d charge handstamp. The 1d surcharge collected the following day in Swindon.
