The Strike Fast, Strike Hard! starter game contains plastic British and German motor torpedo boats, plastic and card tokens, the rules and a variety of other play aids – everything you need to take to take on your opponents fleet. The range will include further plastic, resin and metal ships, aircraft and scenery.

BRITISH VOSPER


Follow this simple guide to building your British Vosper MTBs.

Carefully remove each component from the frame with clippers or a craft knife. Trim off excess plastic before assembling. Test fit all parts before applying glue.

We recommend using polystyrene cement to assemble the kit, and to use this in a well-ventilated area.

Keep tools, glues, paints and small components away from children. Warlord Games recommend this kit for ages 14 and over.


Follow this simple guide to building your German Kriegsmarine S-boats.



Paint the gun with a mix of 70% 990 Light Grey and 30% 987 Medium Grey; finish off with Gun Metal.



Paint the deck with 836 London Grey.




Paint the deck with 836 London Grey.

Paint the torpedoes with Platemail Metal; finish off with Black and Greedy Gold.



Paint the guns with 989 Sky Grey; finish off with Gun Metal.
